 for Helen's potato salad.

SFX: The table falls guiet. Helen clarifies, "it's a three-bean salad."

VO: She should gone full Christmas at ALDI. Good. Different.

Generous

SFX: We're at a Christmas feast.

VO: This year, Go Full Christmas with \$10 off Berg Aussie half leg ham, now just \$8.99 a kilo – bring it to the feast and look heaps generous.

SFX: People gush over how good the ham is.

VO: They'll never know. But you'll know. And we'll know. ALDI. Good. Different.

Santa Magic

SFX: we're at a Christmas gathering.

VO: With fresh Aussie Tiger Prawns for just \$24.99 a kilo,
you can go full Christmas for less,
with more prawns than you can shake a Christmas tree at.

SFX: We hear the rustle of branches and clink of ornaments as someone shakes a Christmas tree at the prawns. Then again as the VO continues.

VO: Just eat your prawns. ALDI. Good. Different.

SFX: Jingle. Jingle.
