



SUBMITTING AUDIO CLIPS FOR PUBLICATION ON THE SI VI PAGE

How to submit audio for the Si Vi section of the website

You may submit audio recordings containing funny, insightful, weird and off the wall content for publication on the Si Vi section of the Siren website. Audio clips must be submitted as MP3 files at 256 kbps, 16 bit stereo.

We do not guarantee that we will publish any clip that you submit. The decision to publish audio clips on the Si Vi section of the Siren website will be at our discretion.

Your licence to us

By submitting audio clips for publication on the Si Vi section of the Siren website, you will be giving Commercial Radio Australia a perpetual, non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to communicate or otherwise make your entry accessible to the public from the Siren website.

This licence from you includes the right for Commercial Radio Australia to reproduce your audio clips as may be necessary to perform the rights you have licensed to us. We will not pay you for submitting any such clips or if we publish those clips on the Siren website.

Your warranties to Commercial Radio Australia

In submitting any audio clip for publication on the Si Vi section of the Siren website, you make the following legally binding promises to Commercial Radio Australia:

- (a) that you have all the necessary rights to submit that audio clip for publication on the Siren website and you grant us the rights to publish or communicate that audio clip to the public;
- (b) that our use of your audio clip on the Siren website will not infringe any third party's intellectual property rights or any other proprietary rights;
- (c) that your audio clip does not contain any content that is defamatory or which contravenes any applicable law including (but not limited to) the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* or similar fair trading laws, the provisions in the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992* in relation to "prohibited content" or "potential prohibited content" on the Internet, laws relating to consumer protection, unfair competition, criminal law or anti-discrimination laws.
- (d) that any information that you submit with your audio clip is current and accurate and not in way fraudulent, false, or misleading; and
- (e) that any audio clip or information that you submit via the Siren website does not contain any viruses or other malicious computer programs that may damage, modify or delete any of the information on the Siren website or affect the proper operation of the Siren website.

Indemnity
